

Doc0001 pertains to #10, pg. 25 in Dodges of Essex County by Joseph Thompson Dodge

Richard Dodge by an Instrument Dated Dec. 1, 1703 which is Recorded Book 22 Leaf 190 and received on record June 17, 1710 among other estate gave to his Son William, twenty acres of the west end of the hundred acres so called lying in Ipswich in the County aforesaid / essex / which hundred acres is in **possession** of my son Richard Dodge the said twenty acres precisely and no more nor less which I give hereby to my son William to be taken off of the west end of said hundred acres by a line extending from the river that is northward or northwesterly from my son Richard dwelling house and so southerly or near across **?an?** hundred acres to the cow pastures of mine the said line to range parallel with the fence on the west end of the hundred acres that stands on the bounds between Thomas Whiter land and it.
